Review of the "Rebecca" by Daphne du Maurier

I want to make a review by thriller novel "Rebecca". I chose this book because I saw it in the <u>Internet</u> and I thought it had to be interesting. So, let's find out if this book is really interesting or not.

The author of "Rebecca" is Daphne du Maurier - an English writer. She was born in the UK on May 13 in 1907 and died on April 19 in 1989.

The story begins when the main heroine remembers her past. She met her husband, Maxim de Winter, and a few weeks later they married. Then a ghost of Maxim's first wife, Rebecca, haunts them. At the costume ball Maxim and the heroine got a love conflict and after this the heroine was close to kill herself. Maxim decides to tell the truth - he killed Rebecca because she said that she was expecting a child not from Maxim. When Rebecca's brother blamed Maxim in murder they went together to London to meet Rebecca's doctor. He said that Rebecca was dying by cancer and she was not able to have a child. That proved Rebecca's suicide and Maxim was saved. When Maxim and the heroine came back they found their house on fire.

Daphne du Maurier's style of giving the story is really good and it always keeps the ambience and intrigue. The main heroine stays unnamed which makes the story more mysterious. All these things together are turned into a very well-written story and I think that "Rebecca" is worth reading to others.
